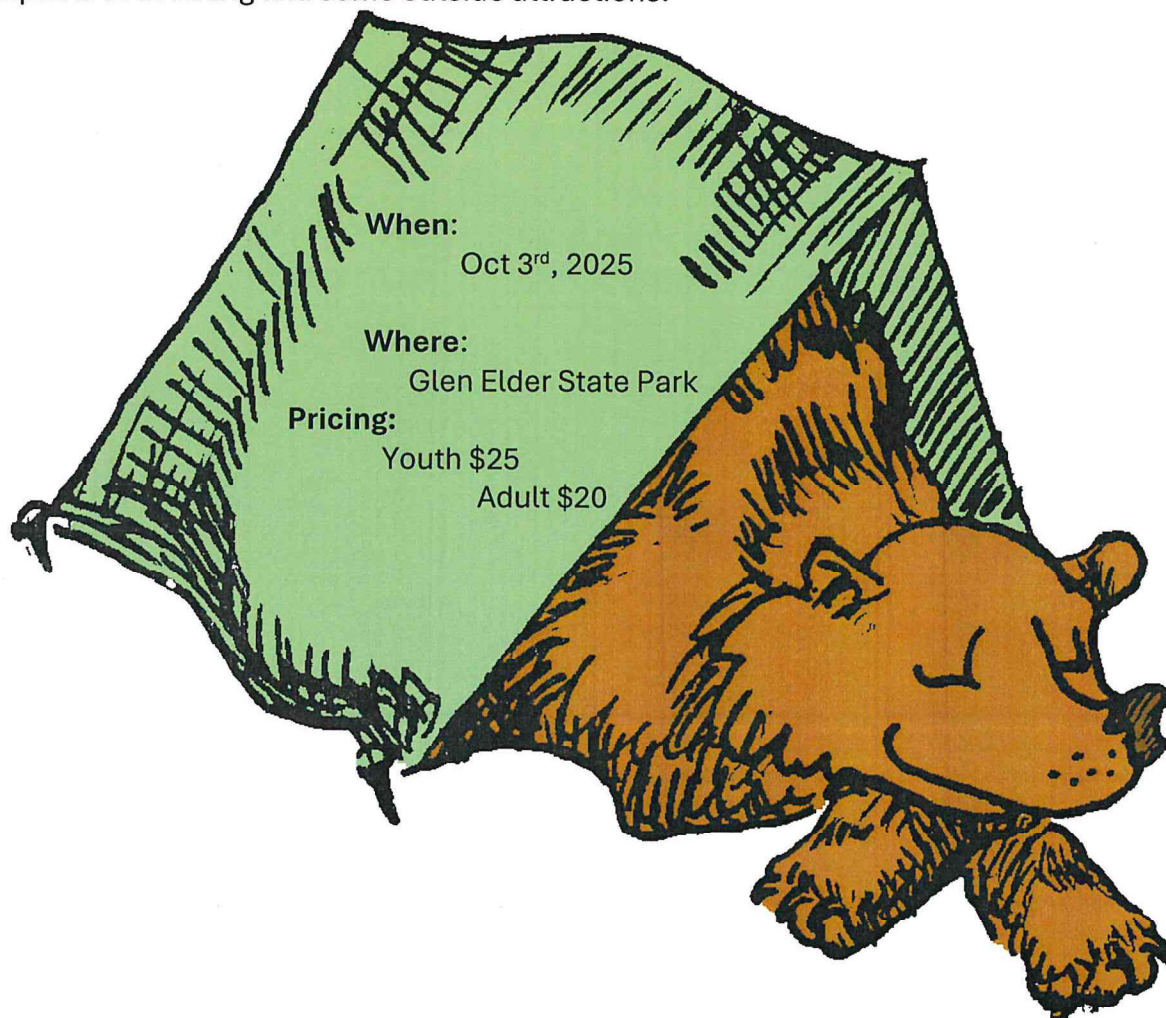

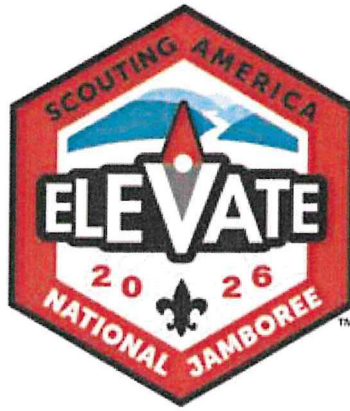

JAMBOREE DATES: WEDNESDAY JULY 22- FRIDAY JULY 31st.

The approximate cost is \$2,200 per youth and unit leader participants (Once travel has been determined we will confirm the final cost.)

Interested participants can register at any time. Late payments are in effect after Nov 3, 2025.

First payment by Friday, May 16, 2025.

Once you have registered and paid, no refund will be given unless you find a replacement who will pay the remaining amount owed.

A deposit of \$200 per participant is due at the time of registration.

1st payment of \$500 per participant is due to the Council office by Friday, May 16, 2025.

2nd payment of \$600 per participant is due to the Council office by Friday, December 19, 2025.

3rd payment of \$600 per participant is due to the Council office by Friday, March 17, 2026.

4th payment of \$300 per participant is due to the Council office by Friday, June 16, 2026.

Registration after November 3, 2025, costs \$2,440 per participant

A deposit of \$200 per participant is due at the time of registration.

1st payment of \$970 per participant is due to the Council by Friday, December 16th.

2nd payment of \$970 per participant is due to the Council by Friday, March 17th.

3rd payment of \$300 per participant is due to the Council by Friday, June 16th.

Travel Dates are still to be determined. Once we start to get a significant number of registered participants, we will discuss travel plans. At a minimum, we will add one to two days before and after the dates of the Jamboree.

Requirements

To attend the National Jamboree, a Scout must:

- Be a currently registered member of Scouting America in a Scouts BSA troop, Venturing Crew, or Sea Scout Ship: If attending as a member of Scouts BSA, a Scout must be at least 12 years of age and no older than 17 years of age.
- If attending as a member of a Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Ship, a Scout must be at least 13 years old and have completed the eighth grade or is age 14 and not yet 21 years of age.

To attend the National Jamboree as a contingent adult leader, an adult must:

- Be a currently registered member of Scouting America No less than 21 years of age Note: Assistant Scoutmasters aged 18-20 are encouraged to register for JST (Staff) or register and participate as a member of a Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Ship

For Scouts BSA

Be approved by the local council

MUST have appropriate parent/guardian to complete online parental consent. (An email will be sent to the parent/guardian of any applicant currently 17 years of age or younger during the application process)

Participate in pre-Jamboree training experience with council contingent and jamboree unit leadership

Submit BSA Annual Health Medical Record. The AHMR must be dated on or after July 1, 2025

Submit all registration fees according to the council's payment schedule.

Adult Leader Participation Qualifications

All Jamboree adult leaders MUST meet the following requirements:

All leaders regardless of assigned position MUST be at least 21 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree.

Be approved by the local council

MUST currently be serving in any unit leadership position

Interested Scoutmaster applicants MUST have completed appropriate leader-specific training

All adult leaders MUST be current with Youth Protection Training

Participant and assist in planning the pre-Jamboree training experience with the council contingent.

Submit all registration fees according to the council's payment schedule.

CAC contingent:

If you are interested in being on the Jamboree Service team, you must register through the national website not through the Council.

Depending on how many Scouts register, we must have a minimum of 2 or 4 adults 21+, and at least one must have wilderness first-aid.

We are excited to announce the addition of new STEM activities for the Cub resident camp including an augmented reality sand table. 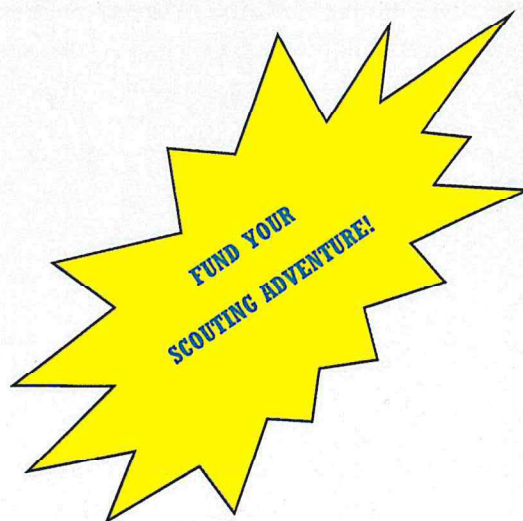

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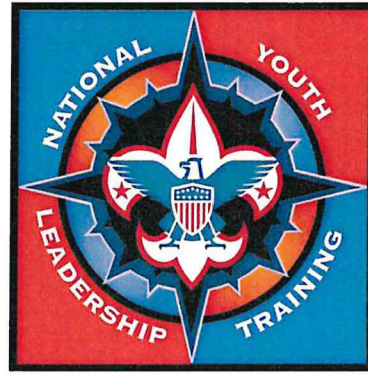
